APPLYING FOR MILITARY AID FOR FAMILY/FRIENDS IN UKRAINE

The AFUO have prepared this fact sheet to provide information about how to lodge your form.

To apply for military aid for family/friends in Ukraine, you will need to fill out the [Military Aid Request Form](#) on the ozeukes.com website.

Who is eligible?

Community members in Australia who have family and friends defending Ukraine.

What can you apply for?

Any type of non-lethal military aid urgently required on the front line.

What are the criteria and “objective factors” which will be used to make a decision?

Requests will be prioritised based on the line and direction of defence.

How much can I apply for?

Requests will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

How long will it take until I receive a decision about my application?

The AFUO will endeavour to process requests within 2-3 weeks.

Who makes the final decision?

The Defence Sub-committee will review all requests and make recommendations to the AFUO Board; the AFUO Board will provide final approval for funding.

What information should I have ready to lodge with my application?

- Details of the person lodging the application in Australia
- Details of the serviceman or servicewoman who the request is for
- An official letter of request from a military unit or personal letter and copy of military ID
